Call for individual technical experts for assessment of Eurostars project applications

Important message to the attention of candidates for the individual experts database managed by the EUREKA Secretariat.

1. General information

a) Type of activity

For the purposes of assessment of the Eurostars project applications, the EUREKA Secretariat is seeking technical experts in their respective specialist area.

This assessment will cover following technological areas:

- Electronics, IT & Telecoms technology
- Industrial manufacturing, Material & Transport
- Other industrial technologies
- Energy technology
- Chemistry, Physical & Exact sciences
- Agriculture & Marine resources
- Agrofood technology
- Measurements & Standards
- Technology for protecting human kind & Environment

Assessment includes formulating comments and recommendations on the applications, completing one Eurostars expert assessment form (referred to as “the Expert Report”) per application, submitting the Expert Report(s) to the EUREKA Secretariat, using the Eurostars Expert web platform, the Expert Report and Eurostars expert assessment guidelines provided by the EUREKA Secretariat.

b) Criteria for inclusion in the list

Interested candidates must be included in the EUREKA Secretariat’s list of technical expert. Those wishing to be included in the list must satisfy the following conditions.

They must:

- hold a higher education diploma (degree or masters level);
- possess a minimum ten years’ professional experience in their chosen area(s);
- from a European Union Member State or a EUREKA Member Country;
- be proficient in English language.

2. How to apply?

Interested candidates may apply at any time from 2007 till 2013.

Interested candidates must complete the attached candidature form

Candidates shall attach their CV using the standard [Europass Curriculum Vitae](#)

Candidates may select no more than two technological areas.

NB: Incomplete and/or inconsistent candidature will not be considered. Candidates may submit only one candidature.

3. Assignment of technical expert

The expert will be selected according to application assessment needs of the EUREKA Secretariat and depending on the availability and professional capacities of technical experts. The date of assessment will be notified by the EUREKA Secretariat.

Inclusion on the database does not imply entitlement to a selection.

4. Contractual and financial conditions

The assignment of Eurostars project assessment will give rise to an agreement between the EUREKA Secretariat and each expert.

The expert is entitled to a financial compensation of 250,- €(two hundred fifty euro) per Expert Report submitted within the time-limit referred to in the agreement.
